The workshop features seven posters in English prepared by Tourism degree students as part of their final course assessment. Each poster explores how equality, accessibility and non-discrimination can be strengthened in tourism experiences in Andalusia.

- To understand the legal principle of equality, as recognized in the Spanish Constitution and in European and international human rights instruments, and its implications for the rights of tourism users, with a particular focus on the SDGs.
- To identify situations of inequality, exclusion or discrimination in tourism services and activities.
- To assess the role of public administrations in guaranteeing equality and accessibility in tourism.
- To propose practical improvements that foster accessibility, inclusion and equal treatment in tourism experiences in Andalusia.
